Eli Karagich Award for Excellence

The Eli M. Karagich Award for Excellence is a special award that is given in honor of the late Eli M. Karagich. The award is given to a boater who displays a dominating performance over the race weekend.

Eli Karagich was born in Niagara Falls, New York, in 1934 and later moved to El Paso, Texas, in 1959. He worked as a civil engineer and helped build William Beaumont Army Medical Center Hospital. Eli raced cars and motorcycles from the 1950's to the 1970's. After deciding to keep two feet on the ground with his hobbies, Eli started flying radio control model airplanes in the 1970's. After retiring from WBAMC in the 1980's, Eli began racing radio control model boats.

In 1986, long time friend, Tom Balliet joined Eli in radio control model boats. Each of them owned Youngblood Mono's from Tidewater Engineering. Both Eli and Tom ran CMB 90 engines and swapped paint each and every time on the water at Ascarate Lake. They both later began racing competitively around APBA District 7. Tom was not yet retired and couldn't make as many races as Eli. However, Eli began to travel all over the US to race his models. He competed yearly at the Southern Gentleman's Racing Association Race in Louisiana and often brought home



hardware for his racing accomplishments. Eli was super proud of the 60+ and 70+ mph patches he had earned racing within IMPBA in the late 1980's and early 1990's. Eli often had great stories to share about his racing experiences.

In 2000, Eli and fellow El Paso area racer and friend, Al Giron, traveled to the NAMBA, APBA and IMPBA Nationals all in the same year. As much as Eli enjoyed racing, he enjoyed the camraderie and new friendships he'd always make along the way. Eli always appreciated races in which a racer earned a win and didn't just score points as a result of DNF's. In honor of Eli, the Rio Grande Racers have designated the Eli M. Karagich Award as it's most prestigous award. Dale Roberts has won the Award 2 out of 3 times. Robert Holland has won it once.

"ARMY" The Armadillo D19 vs D7 Award

"ARMY" the Armadillo was created as the District 19 versus District 7 Shootout trophy. This trophy travels with the winning district each year.

District 19 and District 7 compete in a friendly district based shootout. Participants contribute a small donation to compete and their points are then tallied. The district with the highest point total is then declared the winner. The proceeds raised from participants is then given to the host club to add to the final donation to the Autism Society.

The D19 vs D7 shootout has added a twist to the race that pushes district members to help each other and work together as a team. Not only do racers focus on doing their best to win for themselves, but their performance also helps or hurts their district's quest to take home "ARMY".

District 19 won the first year and repeated again in 2013 with the slimmest of margins. District 7 continues to gear up to try and bring "ARMY" back home to NAMBA District 7.


